

What: 2-Day, Pastel Painting Workshop with nationally recognized artist:

Pamela C. Newell

Class Description: Learn the secrets of creating luminous artwork using soft & hard pastels as a painting medium. Choose your favorite subject matter and bring your best photos, or paint directly from your own still life. Composition, focal point, value, color, mass and line will be explored, including elements that create a successful painting. Learn the various techniques in the creation of an under-painting or “toned ground”. Techniques using both hard and soft pastel will be shown. Differences in pastel painting surfaces will be discussed. We’ll even talk about framing.

Come ready to paint, observe a demo, and get and lots of one-on-one attention at your easel. Instruction is tailored the goals of each artist in a relaxed atmosphere encouraging experimentation. Prepare to enjoy yourself and have fun. *This isn't your mama's pastel!* (This class is best for persons who have had some art instruction and/or experience. It is not necessary to have worked with pastels before.)

About Pamela C. Newell:

Pamela C. Newell is an award-winning artist, whose pastel and oil paintings have been recognized in many regional and national juried competitions including the Hoosier Salon, Indiana Heritage Arts, and Chicago Pastel Painters National Juried Competition. Specializing in impressionistic style paintings of landscapes, gardens, and still life, her expressive work reflects a love of gardening and nature. She uses rich color to describe light and mood of the moment expressed in each painting. Her luminous soft pastel paintings were selected for the Richmond Art Museum's, “Poetry & Passion: The Art of Pastel, Invitational exhibit” and a collaborative show with a Smithsonian Museum SITES exhibit. Galleries include The Hoosier Salon Gallery, Indianapolis, and The Brown County Art Guild, Nashville. Her pastel and oil paintings have earned the Indiana Artisan designation. The Fishers artist is, a faculty member of the Indianapolis Art Center, teaches workshops at the Hamilton County Art Center and around the state.
